We as a team are aware of the following regulations:

The team will receive up to 100 series points (same as winning in D1) for marshalling an event. These points will be awarded before the next tournament, so they are considered for the seeding.

The team will receive those points only, if the players who refereed also played in at least 2 Millennium events, to be checked at the end of the season. The purpose of that rule is to avoid that teams set up a group of "guests" to referee instead of their regular players. If this happens, points will be deducted or totally removed before the season ends, so that series ranking might be affected, including promotion or relegation.

The team will receive up to 1000€, if all requirements have been met and communication with the team before, during and after the event has been flawless. This sum will be given as a virtual voucher for the team's license fee for next season.

The team cannot use players from other teams as referees.

The team has to bring 8 referees to the event agreed upon.

Each referee needs to have a Millennium Series ID-card.

The names of the referees have to appear on the list above.

The event organizer will provide the referee team with hotel accommodations on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, food and drinks during the days of refereeing - all other costs i.e. transportation etc. will have to be covered by the team.

The team is in no way guaranteed that all referees will be placed on the same field - The distribution of the referees on the fields is the decision of the MS Referee Manager.

The team will not receive any points for referees if they are found to be acting in a unsportsmanlike manner or if the team are found to be unable to referee properly due to the abuse of alcohol or any other stimulants. The team can be excluded from the Series if they do not live up to these rules.

All the referees have to be able to communicate in English and the team is responsible for each referee to know and understand the Millennium Series rules.

The referee teams must provide the event organizer with any help needed on the fields during the days of the event.

The referees must be present at the fields at least 1 hour before the first game each day. If for any reason the team does not have 8 referees on the fields, the team will lose the points awarded for refereeing.

The team is responsible for their refs to wear exclusively the gear issued to them. The team is responsible for their refs to give back the gear after the event in a timely fashion and in the best conditions possible.

Teams are responsible for full cooperation of their refs with the MS Ref Manager. The MS Ref Manager is required to assess both general cooperation of teams and effort/ability on field. If necessary, he has to deduct points in an appropriate manner.

If more teams than needed apply for reffing, the MS Ref Manager will pick, taking into consideration among other attributes: number of refs with valid EUROREF certification in team and former ref experience in the MS as team refs.

All referees must attend the mandatory ref meeting at registration day!!
